Question: From the time Amazon says they have received my shipment of books, how long is processing/shelving before it is actually listed?

Answer: Usually the same day.

Question: Can books be delivered to the Amazon Fulfillment center in my city by hand instead of shipped?

Answer: No

Question: Do we have to buy a hand-held scanner?

Answer: No

Question: When is textbook season and when does it end?

Answer: First week in January until middle Feb. And again in Late July to beginning of Sept.

Question: When should I send my books to Amazon?

Answer: End of December but keep sending -- there is no end. **Textbooks sell all year long**, They are just in more demand (IE: Higher Prices Paid) during the two textbook seasons.

Question: When there are new editions available, can you still list the books from old editions? Do they sell?

Answer: New editions will usually have a new UPC. You should always sell the edition that you are listing under. So no, don't list an older edition under a listing for a new edition. If the UPC is the exact same note in the condition notes which edition it is.

Question: I selected 3 books from the Trade-in link and found the lowest Used book price, FBA price and rank. How many books do you recommend to buy for selling as FBA?

Answer: Depends on your tolerance for risk and how sure you are that its a winner. But in general if you are just starting out I would recommend no more than 3 or 4.
